REBUILT TOOL PROCESS

1. Raw used tools are purchased.



2. Tools are broken down into their parts and bad ones are discarded.



3. Good parts are then re-machined, bead blasted, stripped of paint and rust, acid washed or dipped to alleviate any residual grease or oil.
4. Other parts are either milled, heat treated, or coated and treated with a Black Oxide wash to protect them from rusting.



5. The parts then begin to be prepared for assembly and are checked with micrometers and other gauges to make sure their dimensions still match the manufacturer's specifications.



6. Tools are then re-assembled with the correct parts and/or new parts.
7. Tools are then tested in our facility and receive a pass/fail certificate.
8. Once the tools pass the testing stage they are taped off and prepared for primer and painted.
